



## HOLIDAY PARTY CONCEPTS

### *A Christmas Story*

*The environment would be Olde England in the time of Dickens with near full-scale building facades, streetlamps, and occasional snow. There would be a dozen characters milling around and interacting with your guests, background sounds, chestnuts being roasted, ... The action would unfold with a narrated voice giving a synopsis of the story and Scrooge and his various spirits appearing on cue. The evening would have become a holiday-themed murder mystery.*

### *Silver and Chimes*

*This would be a stark red and silver themed event, bold décor and lighting effects with very brassy music. ### *A Charlie Brown Christmas*

*Sam Houston Park in downtown Houston would be the setting for a reenactment of this Christmas movie special. With the historic homes acting as our "kids" neighborhood, foam costume characters would depict the main action of the classic – Charlie Brown trying to kick a field goal, the spare Christmas tree becoming magically adorned, ... The adjoining Heritage House and tent structure would provide a cozy atmosphere for the rest of the evening's enjoyment.*
