***Decor: burlap dressed service tables accented with blue speckled enamel

***Fried Catfish Filets with Tarter Sauce and Spicy Red Sauce  
Crisp Garden Vegetables with Creamy Spinach Dip***

***Decor: served from a replica of an East Texas Bait Shack laden with fish nets and poles, bait buckets, life preserves etc. and accented with piney woods style greenery***

**The Permian Basin**

***Oil Baron's Table***

***cascades of grapes and strawberries surround assorted cheese tortes with homemade melba toasts and crackers, warm artichoke dip with herbed pita chips, and cool salmon mousse with French bread rounds***

***Decor: replicas of oil derricks outlined with tiny white lights resting in the center of this table, accented with assorted greenery, whole fruits, and vegetables***

**The South Texas Ranges**

***Quesadilla Station***

***grilled tableside guests enjoy assorted quesadillas including crayfish, smoked chicken, spicy black bean, and smoked duck served with assorted salsas and condiments***

***Cocktail Chicken Enchiladas Verde***

***Warm Queso Flamada with Tri Colored Chips***

***Decor: sombreros, serapes, piñatas, and Mexican paper flowers with accents of Mexican pottery and terra cotta service ware***

**To complete our Roadhouse, there will be a Gambler character circulating, performing sleight-of-hand tricks; a mutton-chopped MC to orchestrate a variety show consisting of: a can-can act; a cowboy singer; and a sharpshooter and rope trick artist. Our giant Texas foam costumed characters – Aunt Minnie and Texas Bob – will circulate throughout.**

**Outdoors, we will have demonstrations of barrel racing and calf roping, along with an opportunity for your attendees to try their roping skills on a roping skid.**

**After dinner is served, our homegrown Texas rockabilly band, The Manifolds, will take the stage to get people dancing and clapping their hands. For the end of the evening, we will introduce our tribute to Stevie Ray Vaughn. A medley of three songs will be played, accompanied to a computer light show, pyrotechnics, and a dramatic unveiling of the Texas flag.**
